<u>19 January 2025 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C</u> John 2:1-11 'This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee'

In this week's Gospel, Mary observed a human need to do something to address the awkward situation that the absence of wine at a wedding feast would create, and presented it to Jesus, confident that Jesus would respond. We follow Mary's example when we bring our needs and the needs of our world to God in prayer, confident that God will answer our prayers in extraordinary ways.

Sunday 19 January - Peace Sunday Pope Francis' message for the World Day of Peace has the theme "Forgive us our trespasses: Grant us your peace'.

Jubilee 2025 - Pilgrims of Hope Pope Francis has declared that the year 2025 will be a Holy Year of Jubilee for the Catholic Church - an event that takes place once every 25 years.

What is Jubilee? Holy Door The Jubilee Year of Hope was launched by Pope Francis on 24 December 2024 when he opened the Holy Door at St Peter's Basilica. From a symbolic viewpoint, the Holy Door takes on a special significance: it is the most powerful viewpoint, the rioly Door takes on a special significance: it is the most powerful sign of the Jubilee, since the ultimate aim of the pilgrim is to pass through it. Originally, there was only one door, at the Basilica of \$t John Lateran, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome. Later, to allow as many pilgrims as possible to take part in the Jubilee experience, the other Roman Basilicas also

In the Diocese of Brentwood, Holy Doors will be opened in The Cathedral of St Mary & St Helen, Brentwood; The National Shrine of Our Lady of Light, Spouse of the Holy Spirit, Clacton; and St Antony of Padua, Forest Gate.
