Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

We would like to take this opportunity to outline the arrangements for the final few weeks of Year 11. The students will have a Year 11 Leavers Mass, which will take place on **Thursday 22nd June at 11.30 am** in the main hall on the Wiseman Site.

This will be followed by a free school lunch. Students are welcome to bring in a spare shirt and/or autograph book for signing at that time only. Students will be dismissed by 1.00pm.

Study Arrangements

Please note students will be granted study leave from Friday 26th May 2023. This begins as of **3:10pm Thursday 25th May 2023.**

From **Monday 5th June** students will only need to attend lessons where they still have an exam to take. However, we will require all students to come into school in order to complete additional revision at the following times:

From **5th June** students should sign in and out at the front office to attend any lessons. All students are required to attend punctually and in full school uniform when they are expected to be in school. All students are expected to attend the Mass and lunch on **22nd June.**

Examination Results

Exam results will be available for collection between **9am and 11am** on **Thursday 24th August**. If they cannot be collected, we ask that a stamped addressed envelope is provided for exam result slips to be posted home.

This should be handed to either the school office or the exams office before **12th June 2023**.

Note that unless the student has given written permission in advance, other family members or friends will not be allowed to collect results on their behalf.

You will also be required to complete a form about your destination from September. Students who have borrowed Chromebooks for revision purposes will need to return their device by **Friday 23rd June**, or results may be withheld.

Year 11 Prom

As you are aware, the school has organised a Year 11 Prom, (which is always a very enjoyable event!) which will take place at The Kings Oak Hotel, High Beach, on Wednesday 28th June from 7.00 — 11pm. As this is a public venue, you must **BRING YOUR PROM TICKET** with you in order to be admitted to the venue. Unfortunately, due to poor behaviour, some students will not be allowed to attend and will be notified separately. The cut-off date for purchasing a prom ticket was Friday 19th May 2023.

Yearbooks & Hoodies

If students have bought a Yearbook & Hoodie, these will be available for collection on results day, Thursday 24th August.

Sixth Form

Letters detailing offers of places in the sixth form will be issued in due course. Any queries regarding admission to the sixth form should be directed to Mr Delf or Mrs Wilbraham on exam results day, Thursday **24th August**. Enrolment will commence at 11.30pm on Thursday 24th August and all-day Friday 25th August.
