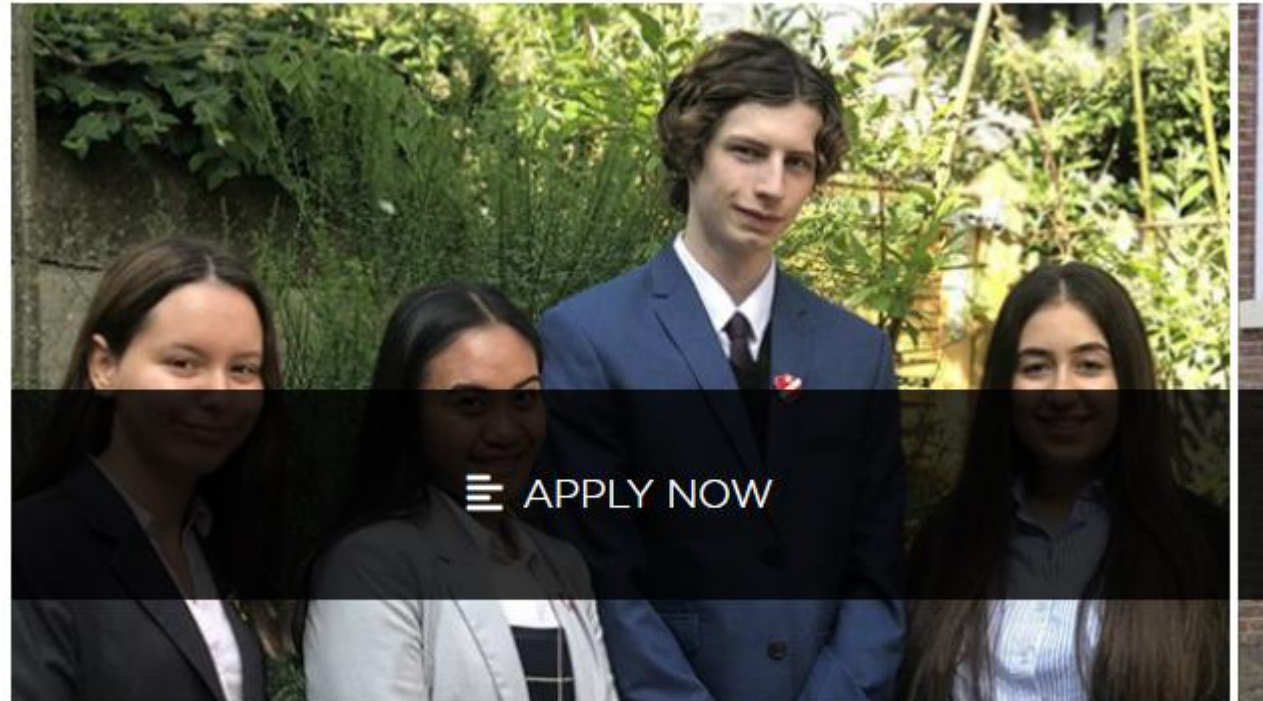

The application process

- Please complete all sections of the form accurately – some helpful hints:
 - Please upload a formal passport sized photo
 - It is vitally important to inform us of any medical, dietary, SEN or other needs
 - For **external students** the ULN, UPN & UCI numbers are essential (current Holy Family students – we have these already)
 - Current predicted grades should be accurate and confirmed by your referee
Please carefully follow the instructions regarding subject choices (you should only choose one subject from each of the option blocks – see video 2)
 - Once you have entered your predicted grades, subject options will be tailored to your current predictions
 - Please complete the personal statement to the best of your ability!



Interviews and offers for sixth form

- All applicants will receive an interview – this is not something to be worried about BUT please ensure you come ready to discuss why you are applying for your chosen subjects.
- For external students these may be conducted virtually depending on future Covid-19 regulations
- Any offer that is made takes into consideration:
 - Your Practice/Mock exam results
 - Your current teacher predictions
 - Your attendance and punctuality
 - Teacher reference
- There are two levels of offer:
 - 1) Firm conditional (a firm offer based on meeting the specific entry requirements).
 - 2) Pending conditional (Internal students will be required to complete the 'Passport to Sixth Form').



Important issues

- We would strongly advise that students calculate a predicted GCSE average from their most recent Mock exam results.
- This should be used as a guide as to the most suitable pathway in sixth form. These averages will be discussed at interview.
- **All offers made are conditional on meeting the entry requirements of specific pathways.**
- Carefully consider subject combinations – ask for help if you are not sure!
